



Advanced Placement (AP) Credit

The University of Michigan-Dearborn encourages high-achieving students to enroll in AP courses and take AP exams. Scores of 3 or better typically earn college credits at UM-Dearborn, and students may apply those credits toward their degree. The following table indicates the subjects recognized by UM-Dearborn and the equivalent course credit that is awarded for scores of 3, 4, or 5.
