

## College Level Examination Program (CLEP)

The University of Michigan-Dearborn encourages students who took College Level Examination Program (CLEP) tests to submit their scores electronically to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions prior to enrollment. To be eligible for credit, students must have enrolled in or after the Fall 2020 semester. Students cannot earn credit for tests that were taken after they enrolled at UM-Dearborn. This chart demonstrates each test and, when applicable, the credit awarded if the minimum score is earned. Students who enroll at UM-Dearborn will work with an academic advisor to determine how these classes will apply to their degree program.
