

DANTES Subject Standardized Tests (DSST)

The University of Michigan-Dearborn encourages students who took DANTES Subject Standardized Tests (DSST) to submit their scores to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions prior to enrollment. To be eligible for credit, students must have enrolled in or after the Fall 2020 semester. Students cannot earn credit for tests that were taken after they enrolled at UM-Dearborn. This chart demonstrates each test and, when applicable, the credit awarded if the minimum score is earned. Students who enroll at UM-Dearborn will work with an academic advisor to determine how these classes will apply to their degree program. Exams taken under the previous scoring model will be considered. Minimum score requirements may vary.
