From Fall 2020-Spring 2024 I was an NSF ASCEND fellow, participating in a program aimed to advance mid-career female STEM faculty at Primarily Undergraduate Institutions. Over the course of the three years, I particularly benefited from peer-to-peer mentoring networks and creating individual development plans - helping me to chart a roadmap for promotion to full and exploring “what’s next.” I will share a bit more about the ASCEND project and resources I have for faculty, but mostly facilitate a conversation around goal setting, identifying roadblocks and strategies for overcoming them, and determining what further support is needed.
