



### Calculating GPA (Students Enrolled in the Undergraduate, COE, or COS Programs)

#### After Admission to SOE:

Your cumulative GPA and your GPA's in the major(s), minor(s), and the professional sequence will be based on grades earned here at UM-D.

#### To be eligible for Student teaching and graduation:

You must have a UM-D cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above and a GPA of 2.75 or above in the major, the minor, and the professional sequence.

#### Exception:

If you have a UM-D cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above, YOU DO NOT NEED TO CALCULATE YOUR OTHER GPA's when applying for student teaching. (approved by the Executive Committee 8/16/94)

The following grading system is used in the College of Education, Health, and Human Services.

Letter Grade	Honor Points	Letter Grade	Honor Points
A	4.0	C	2.0
A-	3.7	C-	1.7
B+	3.4	D+	1.4
B	3.0	D	1.0
B-	2.7	D-	0.7
C+	2.4	E	0.0

Grade point averages (scholastic averages) are computed by dividing the honor points a student has earned by the hours elected.

#### EXAMPLE:

3 hour course (A) = 12  
 2 hour course (A) = 8  
 3 hour course (B) = 9  
3 hour course (C+) = 7.2  
 11 credit hours      36.2 honor points = 3.29 GPA
