

Completers Year Out Survey 2024-25

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) administers a survey to completers from all EPPs across the state the year following graduation or completion of the teacher certification program. The electronic survey is sent directly to the completers and then MDE collects and sends the results to the EPPs. Completers select one response for each item: To a Great Extent, to a Moderate Extent, to a Small Extent or Not at All.

Analysis

Three categories had ratings above the 80% benchmark. The category of Career Support was the lowest scoring category for both UM-Dearborn and the State Average.
