

OSEH Standard of Care #5: Biological Safety Cabinet (BSC) Warranty Work

1.0 Scope

- 1.1 BSC manufacturers can request to have OSEH Technicians perform warranty work on their BSCs at The University of Michigan. This will often greatly reduce the time a cabinet is out of service due to scheduling delays seen with outside certification and maintenance companies.

2.0 Stipulations

- 2.1 OSEH can decline the work for any reason including scheduling, unfamiliarity with the manufacturer or model, and unfamiliarity with the maintenance to be performed.
- 2.2 The BSC manufacturer must provide training to BLS technicians periodically and when requested on new or modified products.
- 2.3 All parts required for the repair will be provided to OSEH free of charge under warranty, including shipping charges.

3.0 Warranty Work Fee Schedule

- 3.1 Typical warranty work may require decontamination, repair and/or certification services. All required work will be billed according to the hourly rates listed in section 3.2 below.
- 3.2 Rates for OSEH Technicians
 - 3.2.1 Standard rate is \$80 per hour.
 - 3.2.2 Saturday, Sunday and overtime rate is \$120 per hour.
 - 3.2.3 Holiday rate is \$160 per hour.
 - 3.2.4 Christmas rate is \$240 per hour.

- 3.3 Photometer, smoke generator, flow hood, velometer, and standard tool usage are included in the hourly fee.
- 3.4 Materials used for the service work will be billed at current prices.
- 3.5 Mileage will not be billed to facilities on the main Ann Arbor campus. Offsite locations will be billed at the rate of \$.50 per mile to and from Ann Arbor, MI. Any airfare, hotel, and meal expenses will be billed at cost plus 10%.
