Features

- 1. Top Navigation Bar:** Use these links as quick portal navigation tools.
- 2. Open Cases:** View any currently open cases. Clicking into the case will allow you to view details and email chains.
- 3. My Success Team:** View all members of your success team from across campus. From this page, you can also schedule an appointment or email them directly.
- 4. My Tasks:** View all open tasks with due dates. Click into each task for more details.
- 5. My Help Center:** View FAQs, Knowledge articles, and your open cases.
- 6. My Quick Links:** View quick links to other University systems all in one place.
- 7. My Quick Links (list):** Use these links to navigate quickly to frequently used University systems.
- 8. Schedule an Appointment:** Click to schedule an appointment with a member of your success team.
- 9. Upcoming/Past/Cancelled:** View details of your upcoming, past, or cancelled appointments.
- 10. My Tasks:** Quick view of future and completed tasks.
