Teacher Certification Program Statement: The University of Michigan-Dearborn is committed to the ideal of quality in the field of teacher education. A screening procedure is employed to help identify those people most likely to achieve the level of excellence defined by the College of Education, Health, and Human Services (CEHHS). This screening procedure is divided into four successive phases. **Requirements at one phase must be successfully completed before continuing on to the next.** Students are also responsible for meeting all program requirements for the selected degree as listed in the Undergraduate Catalog.

This checklist is designed for your personal use to assist you with monitoring progress throughout your program.
