If you believe you qualify for in-state tuition and any of the following circumstances apply, you are required to file an **Application for In-State Tuition** and be approved before your status can be changed to in-state:

- You live outside of Michigan for any purpose, including but not limited to education, volunteer activities, travel, or employment.
- You attended or graduated from a high school or college outside of MI.
- You lived or worked outside of MI at any time in the last 3 years.
- You are not a US. Citizen.
- Your spouse, partner, or parent is in MI as a nonresident student, medical resident, fellow, or for military assignment or other temp employment.
- You are 24 years of age or younger and a parent lives outside of MI.
- You previously attended any U-M campus (Ann Arbor, Dearborn, or Flint) as a nonresident.
