Study Abroad Financial Aid Overview (for current degree-seeking UM-Dearborn students)

- [Conditions of Award](#): Eligibility requirements for all financial aid
 - [Courses in Program of Study \(CPoS\)](#): Only courses that count towards your degree are eligible for financial aid
1. Need-based study abroad scholarship (if program tuition goes to UM-Dearborn)
 - a. [Go Global Scholarship](#)
 - b. To be eligible, students must:
 - i. [Apply for FAFSA](#) for the year of the program:
 - ii. Apply for the program in [M-Navigator](#)
 - iii. Once accepted for a program, students should submit the “Study Abroad Aid Application” in their post-acceptance application in M-Navigator
 2. Internal Tuition Scholarships (if program tuition goes to UM-Dearborn)
 - a. See UM-Dearborn’s [Scholarships](#) page for a list
 - b. Review terms and conditions of the award or [contact the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships](#) about eligibility for term of attendance
 - c. Visit [Scholarship Universe](#) to explore other internal scholarship options
 3. Federal Aid (Grant or Loan)
 - a. To be eligible, students must:
 - i. [Apply for FAFSA](#) for the year of the program
 - ii. Be enrolled at least half time for the semester of the program (aid is prorated)
 - iii. Funding is based on annual eligibility. If you have questions about terms of eligibility for financial aid, [contact the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships](#).
 4. *Other Internal Study Abroad Scholarships*
 - a. Program-specific scholarships
 - i. These awards can be competitive and amounts vary each year based on funding.
