- e. Provost Team Update Gabriella Scarlatta
 - Congratulations to staff milestones and Chancellor's Staff Committee for the Recognition event.
 - ii. HLC was a success, the opening meeting with Chancellor, Provost and Mitch Monday, closing meeting was yesterday. Hoping for a successful review.
 - iii. Working on white paper for more majors/programs to be offered online. We should have a clear plan in January to present to the Chancellor.
 - 1. Will advising staff be provided information prior to the presentation for the Chancellor? Paper will include the
