- d. Chancellor Team Update Chancellor Grasso
 - i. MLK day of service had good participation.
 - ii. Next week will be the State of the University address, followed by the Winter Carnival.
 - iii. There was a federal transition memo sent to everyone today, addressing executive orders and new legislation. We have a team in Ann Arbor that is working to review everything and help us navigate it.
- e. Provost Team Update Maureen Linker
 - i. The Provost is in Morocco, guiding alums and donors.
 - ii. Thank you for participating in the welcome initiative on Jan 6-7.
 - iii. SURE applications are underway, the deadline is this Friday.
 - iv. Faculty award deadlines are approaching January 27
 - v. <u>Graduation and Retention Summit</u> is February 21, which allows faculty, staff and students to come together and talk about best practices.
 - vi. Grants Received
 - 1. Dean of Students, Amy Finley: \$260,000 grant to help with student degree completion and Pantry.
 - 2. Joan Remski: \$319,000, 3 yr grant that helps to accelerate STEM success at UM Dearborn requiring infrastructure with Ann Arbor (eCoach)
 - Maureen Linker: \$169,000 to train START advisors on appreciative advising, resulting in a credential at the end with training for 2hrs/week. Provides a framework for advisors to help students think about life goals.
 - 4. Student Employment Advisory Council Experience+, Career Services: \$40,000 from Arizona State University to continue progress.
 - vii. Question: What guidance does the campus use for closing due to cold temperatures? Rima said it's a question they can take back to leadership and maybe address at the event next week or provide that feedback later. Concerns:
 - 1. One Stop student complaints
 - 2. Older cars
 - 3. People that don't drive
 - 4. Kids off of school
 - 5. Students who are not familiar with extreme cold, and may not have the proper attire or knowledge on how to stay safe.
 - 6. Waiting for the shuttle

Response from Ken Kettenbiel: There was discussion about a possible closure due to the cold weather. While it is very cold outside, we did not feel the weather conditions were severe enough to cancel classes. We were under a cold weather advisory, not a warning. When the university closed a few years back

for the cold, wind chills were -25 or below and the actual temperature hovered around 0 for a few days. I believe if conditions were worse by 10 degrees or so, there may be cancellations.
